

NORTH TEXAS ROUNDUP 2014 DRIVING RULES

Rules are in place to ensure that everyone has an enjoyable and safe experience during this event.

1. All Drivers must attend the Friday morning Drivers' Meeting at 8:00. A roll call will be taken. Passing areas will be explained in the Drivers' Meeting and there will be a review of the flags used to communicate with you on track. Gates are open at 7:00 AM. If you are coming in on Thursday and want to leave your car at the track, contact Maggie at ECR to coordinate, 940-466-9775.
2. All first time Drivers will stay behind and attend the High Performance Driving Education classroom around 8:15 AM on the main floor of the ECR building. You will be introduced to your instructor and then the instructors and Advanced Group will be released for the first track session.
3. Passing in unapproved areas will result in a Black Flag and the Driver will be required to come into the hot pits for a discussion with the Chief Steward.
4. Two (2) wheels off the track will result in a Black Flag (except Advanced) and the Driver will be required to come into the hot pits for a discussion with the Chief Steward.
5. Four (4) Wheels off the track or significant loss of control determined by ECR personnel will result in a Black Flag and the Driver will be required to come into the hot pits for a discussion with the Chief Steward and may result in loss of Driving Privileges for the remainder of the session.
6. Two (2) Black Flags during a session will result in loss of driving privileges for the remainder of the session.
7. Three (3) Black flags for the day will result in loss of Event Driving Privileges and you will be asked to park your car.
8. Slower cars (Drivers) shall point faster cars around in established passing areas. Do not keep faster traffic behind you! The driver being passed should hold the line. It is up to the passing driver to make a safe pass, only one car at a time. However, you may be faster on the straight away so be considerate and slow down and let the other driver finish his pass.
9. A Rabbit is a person slightly faster than you. Let him by and study his driving lines. You might find he is better in some areas than you and you could improve your lap time.
10. Racing or aggressive driving will not be permitted. Anyone violating the rules of this high speed driving school will be asked to leave.
11. No passengers are allowed, except instructors, event participants for the purposes of instruction. Passengers must have an automobile license in their state of residence.
12. Remember while on track, you must keep all limbs inside the car. No hand-held cameras or cell phones. No smoking. Leave your helmet on until you are in the pits. Pay attention to the flags. Locate the Corner Stations and watch for flags. Keep your concentration level on until you turn the key off. Many times off-course excursions take place on the cool-off lap.
13. After taking the checkered, drive half speed for that final lap to cool the brakes and engine. When you exit the car, do not activate your E-Brake. Leave the car in gear or park.
